Objective of Learning Resource

Encourages learners to think about the type of lifestyle they wish for and enables them to consider how they could achieve this. Enables them to view occupations against earnings and provides stimulus for discussion on the reality of career routes versus lifestyle choice. Finally learners will consider how they will reach their desired lifestyle by reviewing the qualifications required.

They should be encouraged to think broadly about the lifestyle they aspire to and what possessions they think they will have. What kind of car they will have/location where they will live/type of house they will have etc. They will then record this on the pre prepared lifestyle sheet in **Column A**.

Stage 2

Following brief discussion learners will be encouraged to calculate how much their lifestyle will cost them. Enter value in **Column B**.

Part 2 – Career Decisions

Stage 3

Learners will consider the type of job role that they will need to have to be where they desire in 10 years time, matching the salary to their lifestyle. Learners will record the information on the Career Decisions Activity Sheet.

Stage 4

The learners will look at the qualifications they will need to reach their desired lifestyle. They will use the Apprenticeship website to research careers and salaries related to each career choice. Salaries and qualifications to be recorded on Career Decisions Activity Sheet.

Part 3 – Progression Plan

Stage 5

Learners will identify the educational and career route they will need to achieve their desire. The task will be completed with a 10 Year Plan, to include short and long term goals.

Part 1 – Lifestyle

Stage 1
